The children at BHOG have avenues of expressing themselves in ways to allow them to heal and to encourage their spiritual and emotional wellbeing as they grow and mature.

With the new CBE Program in Kenya, our students began Vex Code Robotics and French was added to the curriculum. Our Basketball team earned a spot in the County Games Competition.

Brase Clinic added a blood chemistry analyzer which expands the labs the clinic is able to run for patients. The addition of two nurses have streamlined services to our everyday patients as well as team patients.

In 2024, we were able to send 13 Surgical teams, 2 Prep Teams, a Medical Outreach Team and a Vacation Bible School Team.

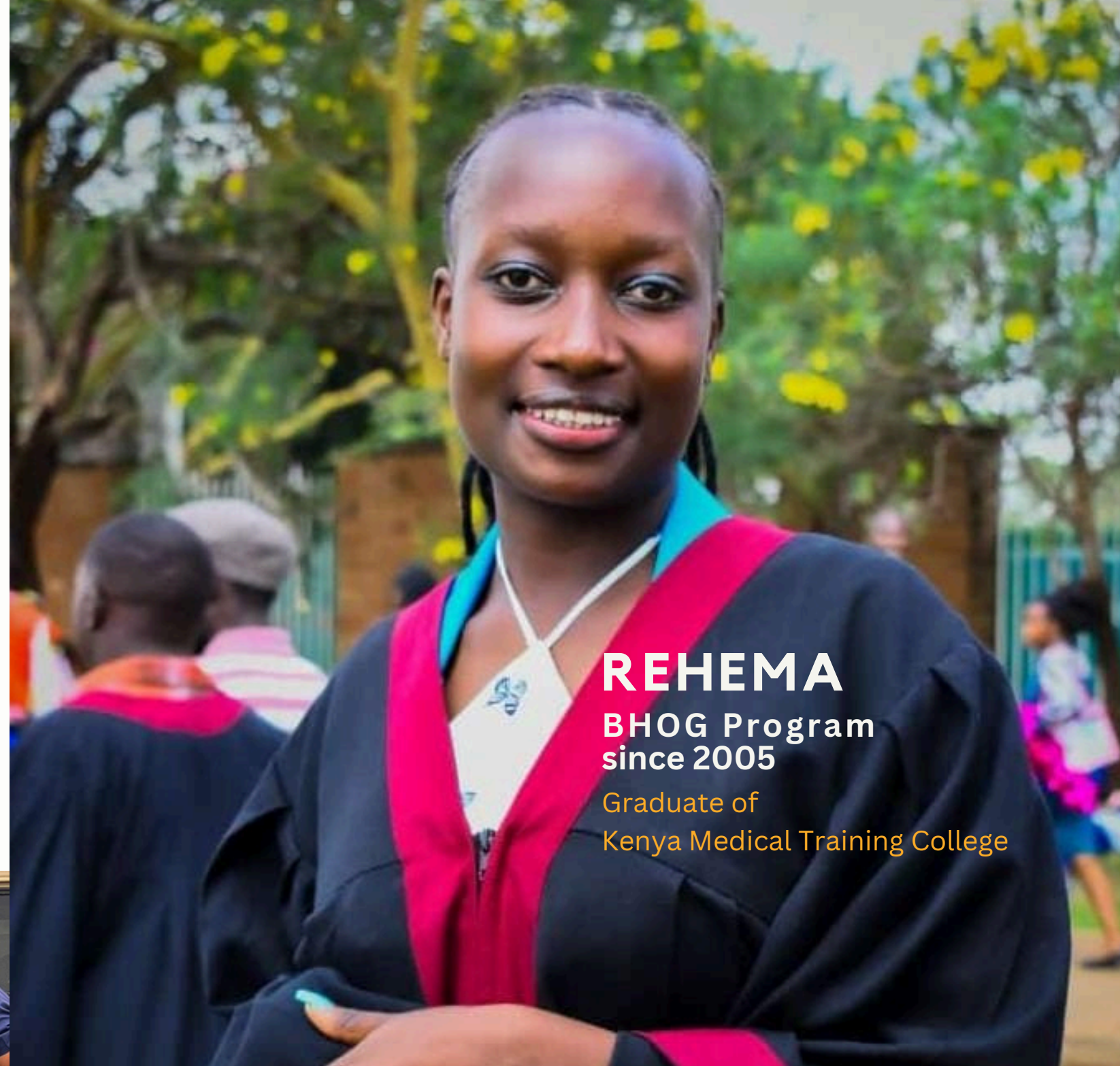
